#### The U.S. Leads the World in Incarceration Rates

2.3 million people are incarcerated in the US, a 500% increase over the past 40 years!


- U.S. represents 5% of the world's population
- U.S. houses 25% of the world's incarcerated people.

#### **Statistics**

- There are
  - 1,719 state prisons,
  - 102 federal prisons, and
  - 1,852 juvenile correctional facilities,
  - 3163 local jails,
  - 80 Indian Country jails
  - Plus...military prisons, immigration detention facilities, civil commitment centers, state psychiatric facilities, and prisons in US territories;
- 93% of those incarcerated are men, 7% are women
- State (all) expenditures on Corrections in 2016 was 57.7 billion dollars
  - up from 6.7 billion in 1985

## The Problem







### The Problem

Average age at arrest in Texas prisons is 35.5 years.

So <u>young families are being torn apart</u> which erodes our communities.







### Recidivism

A fundamental concept in criminal justice.

It refers to a person's relapse into criminal behavior and, as a result, return to prison.







"...the greatest hope for an inmate to avoid returning to prison is to undergo a religious conversion experience during his incarceration."

A community spiritually freed from the effects of imprisonment reaching all impacted by incarceration, through the love, hope, and faith found in Jesus Christ.







### The economic IMPACT of reducing recidivism







By reducing recidivism, Kairos IMPACTS all Texas taxpayers







## Annual Texas Taxpayer Savings 2019

Texas Kairos graduates: 3,486

Recidivism: 68% within 3 years = 2,370

Kairos reduces this by 33% = 782

Texas taxpayer savings: (782)(\$25,000)(3 years)

Savings attributed to the 2019 Kairos graduates \$58,650,000
