Cookies baked with prayer are a significant tool used during a Kairos Weekend. They are used to soften the hardened and calloused hearts to allow Jesus to come in through the power of the Holy Spirit !!! We need as many as 5000 dozen cookies for a 3500 resident prison on a Kairos Weekend. We ask that these cookies be about 2” in diameter cooked full of prayer and packaged 3-dozen in a gallon size Ziploc bag or layered in boxes with waxed paper or paper towels in between layers. Chocolate Chip, Oatmeal, and Peanut Butter are some of the favorites.

Some Residents have not had correspondence from their children or other family members for long periods of time. A letter from an adult or a child means a great deal to them. The Holy Spirit uses a simple drawing with the message,

“GOD LOVES YOU & SO DO I” is a powerful tool to change lives. This has proven to be much more effective than using pressure tactics with extensive Bible quotes (Children are encouraged to include first name and their age only – please do not include last names when writing letters).

## #3. Sponsorships



We ask our communities to help us with the sponsoring of the residents who come to participate in a multi-denominational three day weekend. Prison residents participate in hearing the gospel proclaimed and we supply food, drinks, and support materials which amounts to an expense of approximately \$150 for each resident. We ask individuals and

all the groups in churches, Sunday School, Music Dept, Men’s and Women’s Ministry, etc. to consider the verses in James 2 “as you think about helping us bring the message of Jesus to those behind bars, so that they may be set free in Jesus as we have been set free through Him.”

In the past, members of the teams have had to bear all the cost. Kairos in Texas has rapidly expanded and is now serving 39 TDJC units and 7 Kairos Outside locations, plus 1 Kairos youth program called Torch. The Lord has shown us that we need to give others the opportunity to be a part of His ministry for it to continue to grow and be blessed as it has in the past.
