



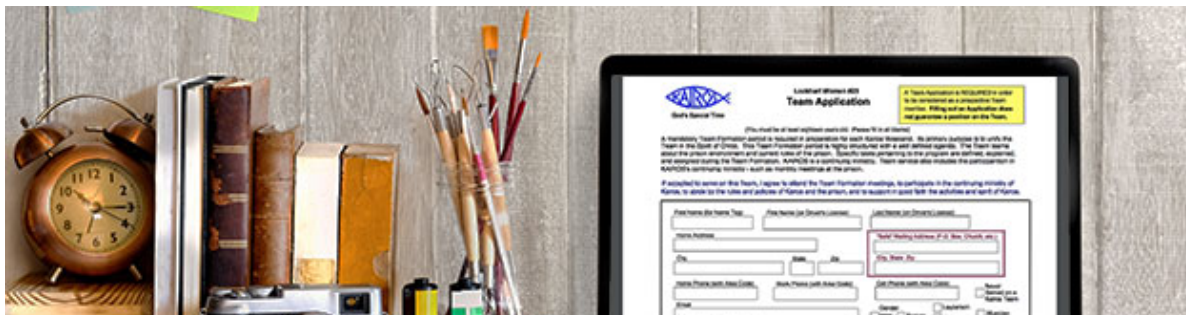

Remembering Kairos History

Do you ever wonder why you are asked about your 4th Day weekend when you fill out a Kairos Team application?

From Our KPMI Silver Manual (page 17):

"Kairos sprang from the Cursillo movement created in Spain in 1948 (Cursillo means "short course" in Spanish). It is supported by volunteers from 4th Day movements such as Cursillo National Episcopal Cursillo, Presbyterian Cursillo, Lutheran Via de Cristo, The Upper Room Walk to Emmaus, and independently ecumenical Tres Dias, as well as by volunteers from independent and non-denominational Christian churches."

This should mean that we as ROCKs and our teams are all looking for and successfully recruiting Kairos volunteers from our 4th Day movements.

At the request of Cursillo, our founders, today affectionately referred to as the "Nine Old Men," developed a prison-appropriate version of the Cursillo program. They adopted the name "Kairos," hosting their first weekend inside Union Correctional Institution at Raiford Florida in 1979.

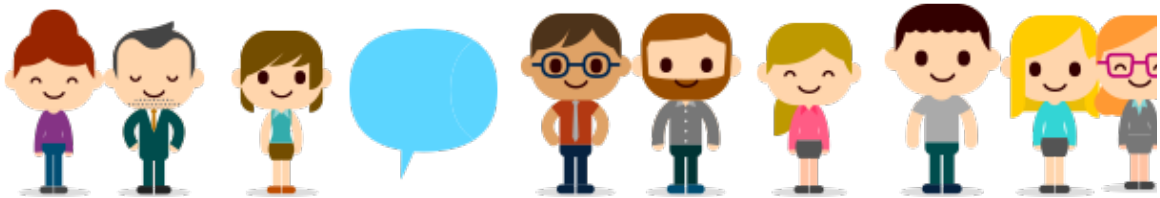
