**Team Volunteer** - Working a team requires members to meet for 36 hours to prepare for a Kairos Outside Weekend. Members share their special talents – musical, spiritual, social – with Guests and each other. For a volunteer application, email us at the address below.

**Angel Volunteer** – “Angels” are special volunteers who work behind the scenes during a weekend. They help prepare Guest quarters, set up tables and chairs, clean, cook, run errands, pray during the Weekend and help with Guest transportation during weekends.

**Prayer Partners** – In Kairos Outside, we depend on God to make things happen, so we recruit volunteers to pray for us from start to finish.

**Agape** – Agape is a sacrificial “love” that takes many forms. It could be prayer or working as an angel. Or it could be making little gifts such as bookmarks or homemade goodies for our Guests on the weekend. All Agape is welcome!

**Provide a meal for a team meeting** – Reach out to an upcoming Weekend Leader for her team meeting dates and provide lunch for the team.
