Five years ago. That's when I was introduced to Kairos Outside. My weekend was #24. But my journey as a soldier in God's army began much earlier than that. He began grooming me for the position from birth I believe.

Fast forward, past all the childhood traumas (some not so "normal", but that's a story for another time), to what I call my "Yahweh University" years. Enter the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. I have been there – more than once. And each time I was supernaturally (and quite paradoxically, to say the least) saved from myself.

I heard of the Kairos Prison Ministry for the first time, as well as all the incarcerated times thereafter, in prison. However, I chose not to sign up for any of the "inside" weekends because I was delusional mainly. I saw what satan would have me see. Having been tainted by "church" inside the walls of prison, where lots of ungodly things transpire, I adamantly refused to try the Kairos experience while there. My loss – that's for sure.

After my final release, in 2010, I knew change was to be had. I just didn't quite know how God would bring that about. Boy...did He show up and show out when I almost reluctantly and very warily accepted the invitation to be a guest. It was there that Yahweh revealed to me my true position in life. With each talk, each exercise, each ceremony, every hug, every prayer, every piece of Agape, every single piece of the puzzle that makes up the weekend's whole was ramped up to that of intense spiritual nature. It was there learned to forgive myself. I learned that all I had endured – be it self-inflicted or not – was parts of the Master's plan. He was grooming me for my real purpose in life: to be His child and to share “me” (warts and all) with others so that they may heal. It took me a half a century to understand that I am worthy in God's eyes. Does that mean I'm perfect now? Hardly! I am, indeed, a work in progress.

Needless to say, I joined the Kairos Outside organization at the very first opportunity. I have not regretted that choice once. I find great worth in helping others (especially kindred females) who have been impacted by incarceration. My seat in God's army has been firmly secured. Find yours, won't you? Join our team. You won't regret it, I promise.

Get Involved!

Team Volunteer--Working a team requires members meet for 36 hours to prepare for a Kairos Outside Weekend. Members share their special talents – musical, spiritual, social – with Guests and each other. The process begins with a volunteer application, which is submitted to the council and leaders of upcoming Weekends. Leaders begin choosing their team many months in advance, so becoming a Team Volunteer can take a long time because of all the planning involved.

Angel Volunteer--“Angels” are special volunteers who work behind the scenes during a weekend. They help prepare Guest quarters, set up tables and chairs, clean, cook, run errands, set up luminaries and pray during the weekend. We also need help with guest transportation during weekends.

Prayer Partners--In Kairos Outside, we depend on God to make things happen, so we recruit volunteers to pray for us from start to finish.

Agape--Agape is a sacrificial “love” that takes many forms. It could be prayer or working as an angel. Or it could be making little gifts such as bookmarks or food, for our Guests on the weekend.

Financial support--Kairos Outside of Midland is a volunteer organization that depends entirely on donations. We have two weekend retreats per year at an average cost of \$10,000 per weekend. Donations of any size are always appreciated. Remember, your donation is tax-deductible.
